Committee members were welcomed at 11:50 a.m.

The following were in attendance: Marc Stallings, Mindy Barker, Barbara Garrett. Mitch Six was excused due to the parent committee member/staff ratio which must be maintained.

Notification of the Meeting: Notice was posted on the school website, around the school, e-mails were sent out, and telephone messages were left for parents.

Elections Were Held: Marc Stallings was nominated by Mindi Barker as Chair, seconded by Barbara Garrett. Mindi Barker was nominated as Vice Chair by Marc Stallings, seconded by Barbara Garrett. Both motions passed unanimously by council members.

Items of Business:

- a) Next council meeting was proposed by Marc Stallings for November 18, 2016, at 11:45 a.m. at Tonaquint Intermediate School. Meeting proposal was agreed upon and passed by council members. An email regarding the next meeting will be sent out to council members with a copy of minutes.
- b) Cindy Benson was introduced as the new council secretary. Connie Ullrich retired in August.
- c) Committee members discussed Trust Land training. Marc Stallings stated training would not be in Southern Utah this year, but hopes our area will be on the schedule for the 2017/2018 school year.
- c) Committee members discussed the Utah School Fund Modification Amendment, which will be on the November 8, 2016, ballot in Utah. This amendment will modify certain provisions and language relating to distribution, investment and expenditure for the State School Fund and Uniform School Fund. Mindi Barker gave a brief overview of the proposal. Committee members were in favor of the amendment and feel the word needs to get out. There is a Facebook page, "Yes to Amendment B," which provides more information.
- d) School Counselor, Brian Armstrong, presented the council with information on Safe Schools and Digital Citizenship. This information can be found under the Safe School section in the council handbook.
- e) Two videos were shown; School Community Councils Touch the Future and Earning for Education.
